The Valley County Social Committee is planning our fourth annual charity **First Responders Softball Game**. The game will be played August 24, 2024, at 2:00 PM at the sports park in Cascade.

Each team will play for a local charity. Proceeds will benefit Cascade Cultural Arts Center and Heartland Hunger & Resource Center. The winner of the game will get 80% of the proceeds for their charity and the non-winner will get 20%.

The \$5 ticket price will include a team spirit pom-pom. Additional pom poms (red, blue, or red/white/blue) will be for sale. The committee will be running a limited concession stand. Children 12 and under will be free.
